WISA LAUNCHES TURN THE TIDE

WISA in partnership with Affectus Australia, SAC Consulting and the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet launched the Turn the Tide program to seafood industry leaders, FRDC, ACIAR and Northern Territory government officials, including Vicky O'Halloran former administrator for the Northern Territory at the World Aquaculture Conference in Darwin. Turn the Tide is designed to connect, enable, support and champion women in seafood. Alongside carefully selected expert partners, WISA's Turn the Tide program will deliver a series of workshops, courses, networking events and other initiatives over three years.

The program is organised in 3 targeted workstreams.

Breaking Barriers: This delivery stream is designed to provide women within the Australian seafood industry development and growth opportunities at a personal level, tailored to the individual needs, career paths and ambition of participants.

Transforming Culture: The Transforming Culture workstream is designed to support individuals and organisations that are interested to learn ways of making workplaces more attractive to women and encourage diversity.

Building Resilience: A series of events, workshops, round tables, networking and collaboration opportunities to build better connected professional networks for women. Through empowering women, the Australian seafood industry will thrive.

ENTREPRENEUR AND LEADERSHIP PROGRAM 2023

This innovative online and in person program will build seafood women's entrepreneurship and leadership skills and capabilities. The program is FREE and the highly regarded Affectus team will be guiding you throughout all parts of the program along with a line-up of experts.

PART 1. Facilitator Training. We are offering an incredible opportunity to train to be an Entrepreneurship and Leadership facilitator with Affectus. You will have a training session to build skills to provide leadership to a group through facilitating discussions.

PART 2. Leadership and Entrepreneurship Small Group Program. You will work online in small groups over 6 months, to develop and action your personal plan to achieve your entrepreneurial and leadership goals based on a shared group issue. The Affectus team (and facilitators above) will be guiding you and we will have experts to help you along the way.

PART 3. Round Table. The final part of this annual feast of women's brilliance will be a 'Round Table' in person gathering where women participating in the Turn the Tide project will come together.

An online workshop will be held 19 June 12:30pm - 1:30pm AEST. Priority placement will be offered to those in attendance.
